

Items Recycled At Eastern Montana Industries

- Corrugated Cardboard-see the picture at right. →
- Please do not recycle corrugated cardboard that has been contaminated
In the following ways:
 - **Packing material** - such as polystyrene foam pellets
 - Excessive amounts of **plastic tape or plastic packing envelopes** (small amounts ok)
 - **Wood** stapled or otherwise attached to the box
 - **Non-paper insulation layer** between the layers of corrugated
 - **Metal** (generally, small numbers of staples do not have to be removed)
 - **Wax or plastic coated corrugated** (usually used to pack produce, usually darker and shinier than uncoated corrugated)
 - Other **extraneous materials** - materials stored in boxes, sweepings, etc
 - No **fiber egg cartons, cereal boxes, pop or beer boxes etc. Material must be corrugated.**



- #1 (PETE) plastic-pop and soft drink bottles as well as single serving water bottles
- #2 (HDPE) plastic –uncolored-milk and distilled water jugs
- #2 (HDPE) plastic – colored-laundry detergent bottles, other colored bottles and jugs. Look for the recycling symbol on the bottom of the bottle. It must have the number (2) inside the symbol for recycling.
- We cannot accept any other types of plastic(numbers 3 through 7) at this time.
- Please – no egg cartons, plastic bags (you can recycle these at your local grocery stores), ketchup bottles etc.
- When recycling plastic, ALWAYS RINSE BEFORE YOU RECYCLE!
- Remove bottle caps!!!
- Must be bottles and jugs only – no plastic coffee cans, margarine tubs, etc. Plastic for recycling must have a bottle neck!!!

Types of Paper Recycled at EMI

- **Newspaper-** should be clean and dry. You may include any inserts found in the newspaper.
 - Bundled papers are nice but if you cannot bundle- slide your papers into a plastic grocery sack before placing in the newspaper bin at our recycling center.
- **Magazines-** due to changes in the recycled paper market, it is no longer necessary to separate your newspapers and magazines. They may be bundled together or placed in a plastic sack together
- **Phone Books**
 - Please separate phone books from newspapers and magazines
- **Office Paper**
 - No fluorescents, goldenrod
 - Envelopes are OK
 - No carbon paper
 - Pastel paper that has been impregnated w/ carbon is OK
 - Manila folders; white, colored and glossy paper; junk mail; tabulating cards; pamphlets; brochures. This mix does not include: newsprint, phone books, magazines, Pendaflex or brown Kraft envelopes
 - Shredded Office Paper-please bag in tear resistant bags or use two bags to help prevent spills
 - All paper should be clean and dry and free of rodent contamination (i.e. rodent droppings, nesting material, etc.)
